#### SUNDAY LITURGY WITH HOLY BAPTISM

During the Sunday Mass we will celebrate the Sacrament of Holy Baptism for **Ffion Violet Fenwick**. We welcome her family and friends as they join us for the momentous occasion in her life.

Bishop Richard Fenwick (her grandfather) will baptise her during the Liturgy. The occasion of the celebration of this great sacrament of initiation is a moment when we, as the Baptised, can recall our own Baptism. In making this recollection we are reminded of what in baptism God has done for us. We became one with the Risen Christ and one with the Holy Church. This pilgrim people, the Church, is the Body of Christ.

St Gregory of Nazianzus writes of Holy Baptism “ “Baptism is God’s most beautiful and magnificent gift. .We call it gift, grace, anointing, enlightenment, garment of immortality, bath of rebirth, seal, and most precious gift. It is called gift because it is conferred on those who bring nothing of their own; grace since it is given even to the guilty; Baptism because sin is buried in the water; anointing for it is priestly and royal as are those who are anointed; enlightenment because it radiates light; clothing since it veils our shame; bath because it washes; and seal as it is our guard and the sign of God’s Lordship.”

This great and foundational Sacrament is not a naming ceremony, nor a thanksgiving for the birth of a child, it is nothing less than the celebration of our redemption in

Christ, our incorporation into the very life of the Trinity. As in all the Sacraments it is not about our action they are about God's welcome into the redeeming life and death of Christ. The mystery of Holy Baptism is that we can become one with the perfect love of Jesus. It is a mysterious union, a new creation that begins within us a life of union and communion with God. It is an Easter Sacrament. The liturgy of the Easter Vigil reminds us of the awesome and awe filled grace of Baptism. The Vigil liturgy echoes across not only that night but across the centuries drawing the Church, the company of the Baptised to prayer and holy remembrance.

### **The New Bishop of Llandaff**

The bishops of the Church in Wales have met in "Sacred Synod" to confirm the appointment of the new Bishop of Llandaff. June Osborne, who has served as Dean of Salisbury for the past 13 years, was chosen as the bishop of Llandaff. Her nomination was confirmed at the Sacred Synod which took place during Evensong at Brecon Cathedral on June 14<sup>th</sup>. She was consecrated at Brecon Cathedral yesterday and her enthronement will take place at Llandaff on July 22<sup>nd</sup>.

Thank you to those who have over the last weeks shared their views and concerns regarding this new situation in the Diocese. This is where we find ourselves at this time. Pray for the Diocese and for June Osborne as the next chapter in the life of the Diocese begins.
