What name have you given your child?


The parents give the child's Christian Name



THE RITE OF HOLY BAPTISM *The Decision*

The priest addresses parents and godparents, saying:

You have declared your wish for Ffion to be baptised. We therefore now invite you to respond to Christ's call.

Do you turn to Christ?
I turn to Christ.

Do you repent of your sins?
I repent of my sins.

Do you renounce evil?
I renounce evil.

Almighty Father, you sent your Son into the world to destroy the powers of darkness. Hear our prayer for this child: deliver her from evil, give her light and joy and fill her with your Holy Spirit, through Jesus Christ our Lord. **Amen**

*The child is anointed by the priest on the breast with the
OIL OF CATECHUMENS in preparation for his Holy Baptism.*

ANOINTING

We anoint you with the oil of salvation in the name of Christ our Saviour: may he strengthen you with his power, who lives and reigns for ever and ever. **Amen**

SIGNING WITH THE CROSS

By his cross and precious blood, our Lord Jesus Christ has redeemed the world. He has told us that, if any want to become his followers, they must deny themselves, take up their cross and follow him day by day.

When the Christian community welcomes you with great joy. I sign you with the sign of the cross + and claim you for our Saviour Jesus Christ. Never be ashamed to confess the faith of Christ crucified.

All: Fight valiantly against sin, the world and devil, and remain faithful to Christ to the end of your life. Amen

Do you believe in the Holy Spirit, the Lord, the giver of life?

I believe and trust in God the Holy Spirit.

The priest addresses the congregation:

This is the faith of the Church.

All This is our faith.

**We believe and trust in one God, Father, Son and Holy Spirit,
the Most Holy and Undivided Trinity**

THE BLESSING OF THE BAPTISMAL WATER

THE BAPTISM

The ANOINTING with Holy Chrism

God the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ had freed you from sin. given you new birth by water and the Holy Spirit, and welcomed you into his holy people. He now anoints you with the Chrism of salvation. May he pour upon you the riches of his grace. As Christ was anointed Priest, Prophet, and King, so may you be daily conformed to his image. **Amen**

CLOTHING WITH A WHITE GARMENT

For you have been clothed with Christ and raised to new life with him through this great Sacrament of the Holy Baptism.

For you have received the light of Christ; walk in this light all the days of your life.


